- Carry out demonstrations of new features to internal and external customers
- Ensure processes are created to evaluate the impact of the changes made, oversee and report on this evaluation
- Contribute to the training and support of all internal departments affected by the system changes
- Assist with maintenance of product roadmaps
- Help produce content for marketing that highlights business benefits and capability of new product features
- Update product documentation and user guides to reflect new product features and capability
- Provide pre-sales support and demonstrations to support new business sales activities
- Uphold and adhere to Idox Information Security policies and procedures.
